

Third Track Project subsoil boring and survey work to begin in New Hyde Park

As part of the LIRR Third Track Expansion Project from Floral Park to Hicksville, a critical transportation and safety improvement project being built by 3rd Track Constructors (3TC), preliminary survey work is being planned for New Hyde Park over the next month.

During March and April between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. survey and geological boring trucks will appear along 2nd Ave, 3rd Ave, 5th Ave, 6th Ave, Premier Blvd, Plaza Ave, Covert Ave and New Hyde Park Rd. To minimize the intrusion within the community no weekend work is being scheduled.

Trucks similar in size to a municipal sanitation truck will be on those selected streets performing soil boring sampling and related subsoil analysis. The work will not require any street closings, and technicians will be seen wearing safety vests and other required equipment.

Residents may have the soil boring equipment generate sounds similar to an engine operating under load, with occasional hammer strikes. Subsoil soundings generate noise similar to a truck idling, with occasional hammer strikes as well. Soil borings and subsurface soundings will create vibrations that cannot be felt more than some five feet away.

Soil sampling will be scheduled at designated locations for the purpose of conducting environmental testing along the right-of-way. As those dates are determined they will be promptly shared with the community.

Surveyors will also be operating along Charles St and 1st Ave, alongside the Long Island Rail Road tracks between March and April between 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and no weekend work will be scheduled. Survey crews will be using vehicles the size of a large box truck and will be utilizing GPS surveying equipment, taking photos and wearing safety vests for prompt identification by residents.

- What to expect - Survey crews will be operating support vehicles. The crew members will be wearing safety vests, utilizing GPS surveying equipment, and taking photographs.

Third Track Report to the New Hyde Park Community – Test Borings Scheduled

As part of the LIRR Expansion Project from Floral Park to Hicksville, a critical transportation and safety improvement project being built by 3rd Track Constructors (3TC), preliminary survey work is being planned for New Hyde Park over the next month.

What: Test borings to obtain geological data adjacent to LIRR Right of Way. Soil sampling for environmental testing will also be scheduled at designated locations with dates to be determined

- Where it will be conducted - Boring locations are at 2nd Ave, 3rd Ave, 5th Ave, 6th Ave, Plaza Ave, Premier Blvd, Covert Ave and New Hyde Park Rd.
- Street access- There are no street closings anticipated during this effort; however, trucks may impact on-street parking as they will be parked alongside the curb during operations.

When: March & April
7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. (No weekend work is scheduled)

- What to expect - Soil borings and subsoil imagery generate sounds similar to an engine operating with frequent hammer strikes. This may create vibrations that cannot be felt more than about 5 feet away.
